6. SPECIAL REPORTS

a. Trees and Mowing - Ronald Linton

Trees and Mowing -

Large dead tree within the triangle section on Forest Ridge Blvd. has not been removed.

Mr. Brock responded that the dead tree is located out of jurisdiction, on private property.

Litter is still an issue on Forest Ridge Blvd.

The blacktopping project is in progress. Workers that have begun bulldozing.

Roosevelt Blvd. looks good, except the chain-link fence to the east of the park entrance is in need of repair.

Beverly Hills Blvd. is in good shape, except for a dead tree in the park.

Mr. Linton asked for low hanging moss to be removed from trees.

Tree moss removal is not a service provided by Public Works.

b. Medians - Vacant

Mr. Fontaine commented on the roadside litter from Dunkin Donuts along County Road 491.

Mr. Fontaine has picked up debris as well as other residents in the area.

Three weeks ago, a county crew did a cleanup around the retention pond on S. Adams Street and left brush behind.

Mr. Brock will put in a request for a litter crew to assist with cleanup.

c. Public Works-Jim Barrows

d. Parks/Community Building- Constance Martin-Carter

Mrs. Martin-Carter commented that the parks look great and thanked the staff.
