#### **OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:**

- Introduction of newly appointed council member Edwin Roberts.
- Larry Brock announced newly nominated council members Edwin Roberts and Louise Bono. Reappointment of chair and vice chair members and assigned duties to be discussed at next meeting.

#### **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:**

Minutes for the December 2, 2020 meeting were reviewed.

- Glen Robertson made motion to accept the Minutes as written.
- Seconded by Jane Mazzacua.
- Motion approved unanimously.

## **APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORTS:**

Period Three 3/21 finance reports were reviewed.

- Thomas Mize made motion to accept the Financials as distributed.
- Seconded by Jane Mazzacua.
- Motion approved unanimously.

#### **SPECIAL REPORTS:**

#### **Streetlights / Fire Protection:**

- Mr. Mize reported that the new streetlights on Deltona and W. Citrus Springs Blvd. are lighting up the intersection well.
- The streetlights on N. Citrus Springs Blvd. and W. Anson are out. Last month, Joan Dias had reported the outage to Duke, and will contact them again on-line.
- Waterline extension is still in progress.

#### **Road Resurfacing:**

- Mr. Robertson offered the historical data and progress report he has on road resurfacing with proposed start and completion dates.
- Mr. Robertson has urged citizens to report potholes to be filled and repaired.
- Current resurfacing contract will be discussed at the BOCC meeting on January 19, 2021 for approval.

## **Boulevard Beautification:**

- Next planting will be in March, pink and white begonias in a checkerboard pattern.
- Mrs. Mazzacua commented that Anna is doing a great job.
- Mr. Mize suggested planting red and yellow flowers.

#### **Grate Installation and Fountain:**

- Grate installation is scheduled to start soon.
- No issues to report with the fountain.
- Mr. Brock suggested in the next phase of maintenance, remarciting the interior of the fountain.
- Peanut plants behind the fountain are doing well, stopping erosion of the back wall.

#### **Roadway Maintenance / Mowing:**

- No new issues with roadways.
- Mowing has slowed and anticipated to start up at the end of February.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**:

- Waiting on new streetlight on the corner of Deltona and Citrus Springs.
- Mr. Brock will speak with the contractor regarding start date for monument repairs.
- Mr. Mize suggested using different materials other than slate tiles for monument repairs.
- In the future the council could consider changing the original design of the monument.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **GENERAL DISCUSSION OF MEMBERS:**

- Mr. Brock will reach out to Glen Robertson and Jane Mazzacua to attend a future meeting to present BOCC Letters of Recognition for their service volunteering on the council.
- Mrs. Dias thanked the resigning members for their service.
- At the next meeting, Mr. Robertson will return keys for the marquee sign and Mrs. Mazzacua will bring the beautification reports.

#### **PUBLIC INPUT:**

- A citizen questioned why the insurance company of the person who hit the monument didn't pick up the repair costs.
- The monument damage was a result of a hit and run accident. An accident report is obtained when damages occur, anticipating we can make a claim.
- The Next regular meeting will take place on February 3, 2021.
