a. Streetlights/Fire Hydrants - Tom Mize

Five streetlights on Citrus Springs Blvd. are not working.

b. Road Resurfacing - Edwin Roberts

Road Maintenance Division responded to a citizen report by cleaning up dirt piles in the road at N. Circular Way and Cortlandt Drive.

- Road Resurfacing Contract was awarded at the BOCC meeting. Once a start date has been scheduled, Mr. Brock will provide additional information.
- Potholes that were reported on E. Citrus Springs Blvd. have been repaired by Road Maintenance

c. Beautification of Boulevards/Medians/Flowers-Pam Williamson

Council members reviewed the 2013 Landscape Architect Report, provided by Mr. Brock.

- Discussion ensued about plant types, colors, and patterns for summer planting.
- Variegated red-green, variegated green-red, and solid red coleus plants in a cottage mix. ○ **Pam Williamson made motion to proceed with the summer planting.**

- A suggestion was made about planting verbenas and pentas in the monument flower boxes.
- Anna Miele suggested planting dwarf magnolias on the East side of the fountain.
- The grass area in front of the fountain is full of weeds and requires new sod. ○ **Pam Williamson made motion to proceed with planting Bahia sod.**

e. Roadway Maintenance/Mowing-Louise Bono

Bill Gilmer, contractor for mowing in Citrus Springs, commented that mowing has been slow and steady since February 5th.

- Mr. Gilmer cuts 423 miles of roadsides in Citrus Springs. The County provides for six roadside cuts per year and 12 median cuts per year. Mr. Gilmer is currently working on a winter cutting, an additional cut authorized by the MSBU.
