BRIEF OVERVIEW:

We would like to apply for Phase III of the Historic Preservation Grants Program, which will assist with the continued restoration of the Historic Hernando School.

This phase includes:

- The replacement and repair of the plaster walls where needed.
- Remove carpet and replace with new flooring where needed.
- Sand, stain and apply sealant over all wood floors
- Construct new ADA ramp to come up to current code.

The grant requires a 1:1 match. The total project cost is \$206,000. The match is not budgeted.

The grant funding of \$103,000 requires a cash match of \$103,000, which may be offset at time of project by in-kind. The match is not budgeted.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- a. Adopt and authorize the Chairman to execute a Resolution authorizing and application for funding to the Florida Department of State, Bureau of Historic Preservation Special Category Grants Program for Phase III of the Historic Hernando School renovation.
- b. Approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the "Designation of Signature Authority". The requested funding is \$103,000 for SFY 2021-2022. The required match is \$103,000 for a total project cost of \$206,000.
