**BRIEF OVERVIEW:**

On December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Agenda item # 7859, The Board of County Commissioners adopted the General Revenue application for funding from the Mid-Florida Area Agency on Aging dba Elder Options for the Community Care for the Elderly, Alzheimer’s Disease Initiative, Home Care for the Elderly and Local Services Programs.

The original term of the application and contracts were scheduled to end on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021, but it has been extended by 1 year due to COVID to now end on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Allocations for year 4 will be the same as the current year.

Only Community Care for the Elderly requires a 10% match. Cash of \$37,500 is already budgeted in FY 21, and the remainder to be made up through in-kind.

This extends the original application and contract term of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021, to June 30, 2022 due to COVID.
