ACADEMIC APPOINTMENT: Faculty Emeritus, Division of Anatomy, Department of Biomedical Education and Anatomy, College of Medicine, The Ohio State University. I am a retired professor who taught gross anatomy, histology, embryology and cell biology to medical and dental students and residents, and graduate students. I was also a member of the Independent Study Curriculum Committee where I designed and wrote the histology components of normal organ systems study modules for first year medical students, and then assessed the students' performance for each module. In addition, I was a founding faculty member of the Undergraduate Biomedical Sciences major at Ohio State University and taught freshmen on how to discover and use the scientific literature. I was the Anatomy division director for 7 years before I retired.

COMMITTEES: Over a 34-year career I served on a large number of committees at the university, college, and department levels. The committees involved policy and advisory, faculty governance, administration, and student review issues. A few examples follow.

University: University Senator, University Faculty Council, Senate Hearing Committee, Senate Faculty Compensation and Benefits Committee,

College: President College Faculty Council, College of Medicine (COM) Dean Search Committee, LCME Review (an accreditation agency) - Sections on Faculty Affairs and Basic Sciences, COM Academic Standing, Academic Behavior Review, Academic Program, and Curriculum Committees, COM Investigations Committee.

A few examples of these services are committees for the American Association of Clinical Anatomists; American Association of Anatomists; editorial consultant for Oxford University Press, ICON Learning Systems, Lippincott, Williams & Wilkins Publishers; external reviewer of the anatomy departments of the University of Iowa, College of Medicine, and the University of Toronto, Faculty of Medicine. I also served as a peer-reviewer for a number of scientific journals (e.g., *American Journal of Anatomy*, *Anatomical Record*, *Anatomical Sciences Education*, *Clinical Anatomy*, *J. Histochemistry and Cytochemistry*).

PUBLICATIONS include 30 technical papers and 49 abstracts in scientific journals, chapters in technical books, and several computer-based instructional programs.

RESEARCH SUPPORT included funding from the National Institutes of Health, American Cancer Society, and National Highway Transportation Safety Administration.

STUDENT ADVISING included 3 doctoral dissertation students (PhD) and 7 Master of Science students with theses. In addition, I served as major adviser to 35 Master of Science students without thesis, and 11 undergraduate student honor theses.

I currently serve as an interpreter at 3 Sisters Springs during manatee season to answer the public's questions about manatees and the Springs and also offer the "Beyond the Boardwalk Tour" on Wednesday afternoons.

Volunteer member of the Friends CRNWR Education Committee and serve as an instructor for the Friends Salt Marsh field education program for 4th and 5th grade of the Homosassa Primary School (2014 – 2020). I have also been an instructor in the Friends 3 Sister Springs field education program for 5th graders (2016 – 2020).

Volunteer at the Homosassa Wildlife State Park where I serve as an interpreter in the Discovery Center where we provide interactive education for children and adults on the Park's featured animal of the month, the other Park animals, and history of the Park, and fresh-water springs.
